## LEC UPDATE

Thank you for your continued support throughout the construction process thus far. With the mass excavation under way, the site has begun to show signs of the new building footprint and the lower level of the Life Enrichment Center.

### Work progress/plans:

- With the trash compactor located in its new home, the demolition of the old dumpster garage (ecological pavilion) has been completed. The trash compactor is now located adjacent to the delivery dock.
- The site crew began mass excavation for the lower level of the LEC. This mass excavation nears completion while the remaining site continues to take shape.
- The LEC building foundations have started and will continue for the upcoming weeks.
- The new water tie-in has been installed near the intersection of 741/Shaker and the new line has been extended across Shaker drive and beyond the construction fence. The water line will continue to be installed up to the second tie-in point in the coming weeks along with the other underground utilities.

It is my plan to provide you frequent updates, as well as photographic evidence of our progress. In the meantime, should any maintenance needs arise or should you discover any issues impacting normal daily routines, please contact 933-5465 for assistance. Please do not physically go to the old Maintenance building - this department is relocating.

As a reminder for safety of our residents, guests, and partners, please stay away from the green space near the fenced area, but feel free to follow our progress from a safe distance.
